Instructions for returning to in person church services

These instructions are intended to keep other people and yourself as safe as possible and are based on sound medical information as of June 24, 2020.

- For those of you over 65 and/or those with high risk, you are welcome to worship with us; however, we encourage you to worship at home.
- If you feel sick, then you should not come to church.
- You are required to wear a mask. If you do not have one, one will be provided.
- The doors to the church will be propped open.
- Every other row of pews has been pushed forward to allow six feet between rows.
- In each row, you are to maintain six feet between you and others on the same row. Attendance cards will be placed in each row to indicate six feet spacing.
- Attendance cards can be placed in the offering plates.
- Offering plates will be on the table near the back of the church.
- One row is reserved for a family unit of more than two people.
- Restrooms will be available. Please use the handicapped restrooms. The restrooms will have both disinfectant wipes and hand sanitizer available. Please use the wipes to wipe down anything you touch. Restroom doors will be propped open.
- There will be no scripture reader or acolyte.
- When in the building if you choose to visit with someone, maintain a six foot distance from all others and/or move the conversation to the parking lot where open air can assist safety precautions.
